Tony Lewis began his martial arts training in January 1991. He received his 1st degree Taekwondo Black Belt in August, 1993 and received his 6th Degree Black Belt in 2010. Mr. Lewis trains in Taekwondo under Master Robert Hardin (9th Degree Black Belt) and Mr. Louie Aregis (6th Degree Black Belt). Mr. Lewis also holds a 3rd black belt in Hapkido. Mr. Lewis is the owner and Chief instructor of Dickson Taekwondo, which he purchased in January of 1995. In 1997 he built a new facility and in 2007 added another work out area and expanded the dressing rooms and waiting area.

Mr. Lewis was a designer at Southern Gage, from which he resigned to become a full time instructor. He is married with three children. He is a former member of the Lions Club and the Child Advocacy Board. Mr. Lewis is a graduate of the Dickson County Chamber of Commerce Leadership Program and is past president of the Leadership Dickson County Alumni Association.
